LETTER OF COMMENDATION

For commendable achievement in the superior performance of his duties while serving as the Systems Administrator at Navy Recruiting District, San Antonio from 9 June 2008 to 30 September 2010. Mr. Carpenter performed his demanding duties in a highly professional manner. His aggressive and effective management of computer assets resulted in computers being available and ready for immediate deployment upon recruiter check-in, reducing the wait time from fifteen days to zero. He maintained the accuracy of the Navy Enterprise Tool (NET), a web based system used to manage Navy/Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI) services at 96 percent accuracy. His efforts directly contributed to San Antonio being recognized as one of only six districts achieving this level of proficiency. Mr. Carpenter was instrumental in identifying, scheduling, and coordinating three technical refreshes that upgraded 65 computers across the district, effectively replacing a third of the commands computer assets with minimal downtime and no data loss. He performed the initial testing of web cameras within the command for use with the Defense Connect Online (DCO) website. His understanding and implementation of web camera technology saved the district hundreds of dollars and the man-hours associated with bringing a recruiter to district for recruiter boards or other training events. His unselfish and exceptional performance was in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States Naval Service.
